

CONNECTICUT PORT AUTHORITY REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

RFP Reference: State Pier New London – Stage No. 4 – CVRR Pier – Northwest Quay and Central Wharf Platform Repairs

The Connecticut Port Authority (“Authority”), which was created in 2014, is a quasi-public agency of the State of Connecticut (“State”) whose primary responsibility is to market and coordinate the development of the State’s ports and maritime economy. Through the issuance of a Request for Proposals (“RFP”), the Authority is soliciting proposals from qualified firms to enter into a single contract to provide consultant engineering services.

Proposals in response to the RFP will be received by the Authority until 4:00 p.m. (EDT) on or before **May 2, 2017**. Proposals should be delivered to the mailing address listed below. **Any proposals received after the time prescribed above or at any other location is subject to being returned to the proposer.** A pre-proposal site visit will be held on April 4, 2017 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. (EDT) at the State Pier Complex Facility located at 200 State Pier Road, New London, CT 06320.

Questions regarding the proposal documents and specifications must be provided in written form and submitted in accordance with the requirements of the RFP. Submission of questions via e-mail is preferred.
