CONNECTICUT PORT AUTHORITY REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) Construction Manager At-Risk (CMR)

The Connecticut Port Authority (“Authority”), which was created in 2014, is a quasi-public agency of the State of Connecticut (“State”) whose primary responsibility is to market and coordinate the development of the State’s ports and maritime economy. Through the issuance of this Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”), the Authority is seeking to retain a professional Construction Management At-Risk (CMR) firm for Infrastructure Improvements at the New London State Pier facility.

Respondents may obtain the RFQ, which is planned to be available in electronic format, commencing July 21, 2020 from the Connecticut State Contracting Portal, administered by the Department of Administrative Services, at the following address:

Submission of questions via e-mail as detailed in the RFQ is required. The deadline for Respondent questions to the RFQ is August 3, 2020 at 11.00 am (ET). Additional items such as an Intent to Respond, organized Site Visit and other requirements are detailed in the RFQ.

Responses to this CMR-RFQ will be received by the Authority until 4:00 pm (ET) on or before August 11, 2020. Responses are to be in accordance with the requirements of the RFQ, which include electronic format via e-mail. **Any responses received after the time prescribed above or at any other location will be considered non-responsive; therefore disqualified from further consideration.**

The Authority reserves the right to reject any, all or any part of a response to the RFQ.
