Section 4-7 of the CGS provides the process of election by the General Assembly. Section 4-1a of the CGS also allows for the term to continue until a successor is appointed.

Note: Following the expiration of each board member's initial term as prescribed by statute, each re-appointment of each such board member shall be for a period of 4 years, commencing July 1 in the year of reappointment.
