

## Addendum No. 2 to RFP No. CPA0024-CM

Section IX. "EVALUATION CRITERIA" of RFP No. CPA0024-CM has been amended as follows:

## IX. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals will not be opened publicly. Firms will be evaluated on the basis of their written responses to this RFP, additional written information requested by the Authority and interviews, if any. All proposals will be evaluated using the following criteria (out of 120 points):

- 1. Depth of experience and knowledge of the firm in providing communications services to governmental entities and the firm's continuing commitment to serving the public sector. (20 points)
- 2. The cost of performing the proposed scope of work (fee proposal). Cost will be an important, but not the primary, factor in the selection of the firm. (20 points)
- 3. Overall quality of the written proposal, and oral presentation, if any. (20 points)
- 4. Organization of the team including the availability of the primary contact, appropriate staffing levels for the assignments including the firm's presence in Connecticut. (20 points)
- 5. Technical expertise, quantitative skill and experience of the firm and the staff responsible for this work. Quality and capacity of the firm's systems, technology infrastructure and equipment to be used in the delivery of services. (20 points)
- 6. Equal employment opportunity record as evidenced by the composition of firm personnel and the firm's affirmative action and equal employment opportunity policies and practices. (20 points)

Proposals submitted in response to this RFP will be evaluated based on the quality and the reasonableness of the responses for each item above. Amongst substantially equally qualified proposers, rates and efficiency will be heavily weighted in making a selection.
